CHALLENGING COURSEWORK

Palma's rigorous curriculum ensures a strong academic foundation with courses that exceed state standards and university admissions requirements. AP and Honors classes are available to students who are compelled to greater challenge and achievement.

Each student works with guidance counselors, administrators, and teachers to create a college-preparatory course of study based on their individual needs, strengths, and abilities. Peerto-peer tutoring is available for any students in need of further support.







FOUR HOUSES, ONE FAMILY

The Palma House System is represented by "four houses, one family." High school students are welcomed into one of four multigrade level Houses, each led by a faculty House Dean and two student House Captains. Each House have an identifiable name, color, and crest.

Students in each House also belong to a smaller group within the House, called House Huddle, which is led by a faculty House Huddle Teacher and two student House Huddle Captains. Generally, students meet four times per week with their House Huddle group. Nearly all activities and events are run through the House System as Houses compete for the annual "Chieftain Cup."
